
Our strategy is driven by our Mission and shows how our efforts align to keeping New Zealand and New Zealanders safe and secure.

Detecting, investigating, assessing and mitigating threats to Aotearoa New Zealand.


Foreign Intelligence

Countering violent extremism and terrorism

Detecting and investigating threats posed by violent extremism in New Zealand and overseas. We work with other agencies to stop these threats escalating into acts of terrorism.




Protecting people, information and assets




NZSIS STRATEGY FOCUS AREAS & OBJECTIVES


We maximise our impact through relationships

We find, understand and mitigate threats by looking not just for what we know but also for the unknowns.




We provide a fantastic place to work

We are modern and experiment with technology



Implementing Strategy 2024-2029

Short and long-term initiatives are underway as part of our strategy implementation programme alongside the delivery of our core services. We are constantly working to understand our environment to determine the next phase of initiatives that will continue driving us towards our strategic goals.

It is important that the nature of many of those initiatives are classified so that NZSIS's capabilities remain effective against those who wish to cause harm. There are governance arrangements in place and under development which hold us to account.

There will always be a large secret component to our work but through publishing our strategy we shed more light on what the NZSIS aims to achieve for New Zealand in delivering our Mission through the next six years and beyond.
